## ABOUT TAYLOR

Taylor Elisabeth-Blair Calhoun was sixteen years old and president of the junior class when she was killed in a car accident.

Taylor was a scholar-athlete who played two varsity sports as a freshman (lettering in tennis). As a sophomore she lettered in tennis, soccer and cheerleading.

Taylor was an extremely positive force on the field, on the sidelines, at school, at home, at church and at play. She was a conscientious member of society through her church and many other volunteer activities.

These scholarships are reflective of Taylor's concerns for others and in memory of what she would have wanted for all students at Huron.

- Positive attitude
- Leadership qualities
- Enthusiastic personality
- High level of commitment to team and teammates

Each current varsity player and each coach on the soccer & tennis teams will have one vote for the selection of Sunshine Award.

## CHEERLEADER SCHOLARSHIP



OUTSTANDING  
CHEERLEADER AWARD  
(\$200 scholarship)

The choice for recipient of the award each year should have the characteristics that Taylor always displayed in relation to responsibility to the team and the happiness of others. To that end, the awardees should:

- Be a positive, enthusiastic & committed leader
- Have a special connection with students both on & off the squad
- Be an outstanding athlete
- Be a cheerleader for at least 2 seasons
- Be a varsity cheerleader
- Have at least a 2.5 GPA
- Have commendable attendance during school hours & during cheerleading hours (required)

The Outstanding Cheerleader Scholarship Award is the equivalent of the MVP for most sports.
